ABC-CLIO Solutions provides digital curriculum with multimedia content, text-to-speech features, translation tools that covers various topics relating to history and the humanities, and the ability to search across multiple databases through one search.

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Note: Our Solutions online databases use the AccessiBe automated web accessibility solution, an AI-based application that runs in the background and optimizes our accessibility level constantly. To ensure that we adhere as strictly as possible to the W3C Web Content Accessibility Guidelines 2.1 at the AA level, the application remediates the sites' HTML, adapts its functionality and behavior or screen-readers, and for keyboard functions used by individuals with motor impairments.

Accessibility features are managed by accessing the admin section of the database. The default setting is disabled.

Evaluation Methods Used: Automated accessibility testing for WCAG 2.1 compliance by AccessiBe, manual keyboard-only testing in version 90 of Chrome Edge version 90 and version 88 of Firefox.
